Fishing trip in Iceland 18-24 July 2020



Saturday, July 18th

Your guides will pick you up at the airport or Reykjavík accommodations in the morning. Those that flew in early will be picked up at there Reykjavík accommodations.

Those Flying this morning will be picked up at the Airport.

Drive to Thingvallavatn and fish there 9-6(depending on flight times). Lunch provided on the bank.

Approx travel time from Reykjavík to Thingvallavatn is 30min.

Approx travel time from Airport to Thingvallvatn is 1hour

The group will split up at the lake and you'll fish a combination of:

Villingavatnsárós- Lake Thingvallvatn

Villingavatn-Lake Villingavatn

Kárastaðir- Lake Thingvallavatn

Kaldárhöfði-Lake Thingvallavatn

Black Cliff-Lake Thingvallavatn

For Ice Age Brown Trout.

After fishing you'll guide will take you up to the Highland Fishing Lodge(approx 1hour 15min drive) for dinner.

Breakfast at the lodge at 8am. After breakfast, you'll head out in pairs of two with your

If you have any food allergies, dietary requirements or requests please notify your



FishPartner representative and we will do our best to accommodate them.

All used fishing equipment needs to be sterilized by customs before entering the country. The price for this process varies based on the amount of gear your bringing but ranges between 30-70\$.

At the Highland Fishing lodge, we have a small fly shop with proven fly patterns as well as leaders, tippetts, etc.

FishPartner can provide all the gear needed. If you wish to use some of our loaner rods, waders and boots please notify your FishPartner representative beforehand so we can have it ready for you.
